About Folds of Honor

Folds of Honor is a 501(C)(3) nonprofit organization, rated a fourstar charity by Charity Navigator and platinum on GuideStar, that provides educational scholarships to the families of military men and women who have fallen or been disabled in the United States armed forces as well as first responder families.

Our educational scholarships support private educational tuition and tutoring for children in grades K-12, as well as higher education tuition assistance for spouses and dependents.

Founded in 2007 by Lieutenant Colonel Dan Rooney, a PGA Professional and F-16 fighter pilot in the Air Force Reserves who served three tours of duty in Iraq, Folds of Honor is proud to have awarded approximately 44,000 scholarships in all 50 states and some US territories totaling nearly \$200,000,000, including 9,000 scholarships for the 2022-2023 academic year.

The Folds of Honor Story

RETURNING HOME FROM HIS SECOND TOUR OF DUTY IN IRAQ, LT COL DAN ROONEY, AN F-16 FIGHTER PILOT IN THE AIR FORCE RESERVES, BECAME PAINFULLY AWARE OF THE REALITY FAMILIES FACE WHEN A LOVED ONE IN UNIFORM IS FALLEN OR DISABLED.

As his flight landed, the pilot announced they carried the remains of Corporal Brock Bucklin on board, asking all passengers to respectfully remain seated while his casket deboarded.

Lt Col Rooney watched as Corporal Bucklin's twin brother walked somberly alongside the flag-covered casket to meet his family. Among them was the deceased Corporal's young son, Jacob. Lt Col Rooney ached as he thought of his own wife and little girls. Seeing the other side of war through the eyes of Jacob, was life-altering.

Sadly, over half the passengers had disregarded the pilot's request and deboarded. Lt Col Rooney decided he had to do something. Not only would he pay tribute to American service-members and their families, he would live as a reminder among civilians that it is our duty to honor the sacrifices of those who preserve the freedoms we so easily take for granted.

Lt Col Rooney committed to spend his life changing the future of America's grieving spouses and children. In 2007, he formed the Folds of Honor Foundation; a 501C-3 nonprofit organization dedicated to providing educational scholarships to the families of these heroic Americans.

Since it's inception in 2007, Folds of Honor has awarded approximately 44,000 scholarships totaling nearly \$200,000,000. In 2022-2023, we will award 9,000 scholarships nationwide to military and first responder families, providing \$40 million in educational support.

The Folds of Honor Foundation has two types of scholarship programs:

- The Children's Fund Scholarship serves Kindergarten through 12th grade students, as well as tutoring opportunities.
- The Higher Education Scholarship serves those seeking a bachelor's degree or a certification at a post-secondary institution, as well as master's degrees and doctorate. Trade school/technical program certifications are also available.

Both types of the Folds of Honor scholarships are based on "unmet need" as determined by documentation submitted by the awardee and can be valued up to \$5,000.

The window of application is open each calendar year from February 1 through March 31 for the upcoming academic year, and Award notifications are sent in the summer.

into active-duty service during times of conflict and national emergencies.





MEETING SACRIFICE WITH HOPE

On September 12, 2022, Folds of Honor announced an addition to our mission, expanding to meet the needs of First responders (police, fire, EMT's and paramedics) across the United States which serve our communities to keep us all safe.

There are over 2 million first responders in the US; made up of 800,000 law enforcement officers, 1,062,800 firefighter personnel, and 241,000 full-time EMTs and paramedics. They respond to approximately 240 million calls made to 9-1-1 each year.

"This move reflects our purpose to meet sacrifice with hope. The decision to launch our first responder scholarships is in reverence to those who paid the ultimate price on September 11th, 2001. The following day was a defining moment in our history, as Americans responded to tragedy by putting differences aside, rallying together, and standing as one. It is our hope that the expanded Folds of Honor mission will inspire unity once again. We need your help. Our Mission is to raise these funds. Honor their sacrifice by educating their legacy.







