#### CREATING PATHWAYS FOR THE FUTURE WORKFORCE

- Aligning graduation requirements to career pathways and providing new ways for schools to innovate will ensure Oklahoma businesses have access to the future workforce it needs. (HB 3278)
- Providing the Oklahoma Workforce Commission with funding necessary to incentivize workforce programs that meet the needs in critical occupational areas will improve workforce development outcomes in Oklahoma and meet economic demand. (SB 1358)

- Employers providing access to affordable, quality childcare for their employees should be celebrated for doing so it's a simple solution to provide a vital service to Oklahoma's workforce. (HB 4147)
