WORKFORCE

Workforce Commission Funding

Adequately invest in the Workforce Commission to ensure the state can meet the workforce needs of Oklahoma's economy through initiatives like the workforce data hub, fully staffing the commission, implementing various programs, and other efforts that promote prosperity for Oklahomans. (SB 662, SB 663)

Work-Based Learning

 Eliminate barriers and liability for businesses providing experiential learning for Oklahoma students. (SB 95)

A-F Report Card

 Change the state's A-F Report Card to focus on improved career readiness for K-12 students and schools. (SB 711)

Child Care

Create a tax incentive for employers that support workers' childcare needs, whether by providing on-site childcare, reserving space at local centers, or offering employees financial assistance for out-of-pocket childcare expenses. (HB 1848, SB 104, SB 256)

LEGAL REFORM

- Ensure transparency measures are in place to prevent third parties from abusing our legal system by funding litigation and unnecessary lawsuits. (SB 625, HB 2619)
- Protect business and their contractors from undue liability on workers compensation claims by safeguarding the role of private contracts between businesses. (SB 642, SB 1013)

TAXES

- Support simplification of individual income tax brackets to make our code more competitive. (SB 304)
- Support modernization of the corporate income tax by eliminating outdated procedures to determine a business' overall tax bill. (HB 1200, SB 60)
