On Site Facility Operating Costs

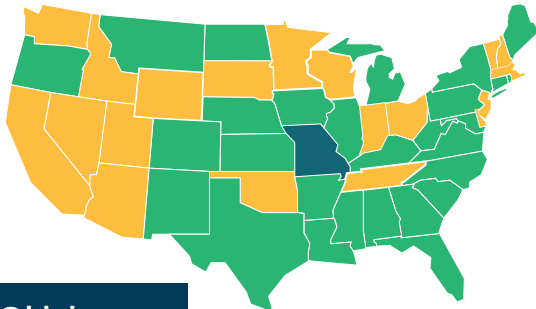
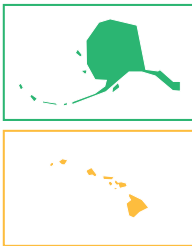
Allows businesses to claim the credit for up to 30% of the cost of operating an onsite childcare facility.



Childcare Costs

Employers can claim up to 30% of the costs for providing assistance to employees to cover childcare costs.

Tax credit for employers is capped at \$30,000 per business and \$5 million annually.

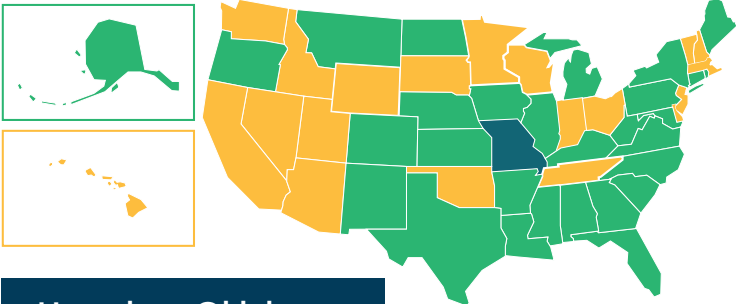
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
